

Minneapolis Sample Itinerary for a High School Music Group

Season: Spring

Three Nights/ Four Days

Day 1 (Thursday) – Enjoy Mall of America

- Afternoon: Arrive at Mall of America
(Open 10 am to 9:30 pm)
Visit Underwater Adventures
(1.2-million gallon walk-through aquarium)
Perform at Camp Snoopy
(The nation's largest indoor amusement park)
- Evening: Dinner at Bubba Gump Shrimp
Free time at MOA (More than 500 stores, 60 restaurants and numerous teen attractions)
- 9:30 pm: Depart for hotel – More free time and optional swimming

Day 2 (Friday) – Explore Minneapolis

- 10-11:15 am: Minneapolis Institute of Arts (Free)
- 11:30 am: Perform during lunchtime in downtown Minneapolis (Possible locations: Hennepin County Government Center or IDS Crystal Court)
- 1:30 pm: Eat and shop while exploring seven miles of glass-enclosed skyways that keep downtown connected.
Stop in at Mill City Museum in the Riverfront District or the Walker Art Center at the gateway to Uptown
- 5-7 pm: Visit Block E – an entertainment complex where you can have dinner, play games, bowl, shop and see a movie: Crown Theatres, GameWorks, Hard Rock Café and more
- 8 pm: Listen to the Minnesota Orchestra at Orchestra Hall (Ask to meet some of the musicians)
Catch a Minnesota Twins game, Broadway musical or see a play at the Tony Award-winning Guthrie Theater
- 10 pm: Club 3 Degrees (Teen Christian rock nightclub featuring live music and a no-alcohol policy)

Day 3 (Saturday) – Discover Saint Paul

- 9:30 am: Science Museum of Minnesota
(Open 9:30 am to 5 pm)
Lunch on your own at the food court at SMM
- 1 pm: Minnesota History Center
(Want to perform again?)
- 2:30 pm: Tour Saint Paul Cathedral (Free)
- 3:15 pm: Como Zoo, Como Town & Conservatory (Free entrance, rides at Como Town require purchased tickets)
- Evening: Dinner at Como (Cafeteria or can pre-order for group)
See a performance at the Ordway Center for the Performing Arts
Or, head out of the city and go to the nation's largest dinner theater – Chanhassen Dinner Theatres, or the oldest continuously-running theater – Old Log Theater (Ask to meet some of the musicians or actors)

Day 4 (Sunday) – Time to head home

- Make the most of your trip and stop in at an attraction on the way home (Options if driving south)
- Minnesota Zoo – Apple Valley
 - Minnesota Landscape Arboretum – Chaska
 - Spam Museum – Austin
